The Story of the Schneider Trophy Air Races covers the history of the Schneider Trophy from its inception in 1912, to the last race in 1931..... and beyond. A time when Britain led the world in aviation design and technology and took pride in its achievements.



CALSHOT : the flying years looks at the history of one of Britain's few military flying boat bases. How many different aircraft types do you think might have been seen here? Most people are surprised by the answer and can see the evidence through my pictures.

SOLENT SKY : (formerly "Southampton Hall of Aviation")

In the heyday of aircraft manufacturing the south of Hampshire was home to more aircraft manufacturers than anywhere else in the world. The world-famous S6 and Spitfire from Supermarine; Saro's SRA1 (the world's first jet flying boat) and the giant Short Sandringham - formerly a WW2 Sunderland. Plus many more exhibits.
